Assistant Accompanist Positions

Closing date for applications is 15<sup>th</sup> March 2019

Sing Ireland is inviting applications for assistant accompanists as part of its International Choral Conducting Summer School that runs from 4<sup>th</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup> August, 2019. The primary duties of the assistant accompanists will be to accompany conducting classes and rehearsals as required by tutors. Other duties may be included depending on the applicant's skills and qualifications. There will also be the opportunity to observe and to work with the renowned principal accompanist, Peter Barley. Sing Ireland will provide accommodation (if required) during the School for assistant accompanists. However, as this is a training position there will not be a fee payment. Candidates will be selected based on suitability to the role by a panel including Peter Barley, principal accompanist, Bernie Sherlock, Artistic Director, and Dermot O'Callaghan, CEO Sing Ireland. The School commences on the morning of 4<sup>th</sup> August and finishes on Saturday afternoon, 10<sup>th</sup> August.
