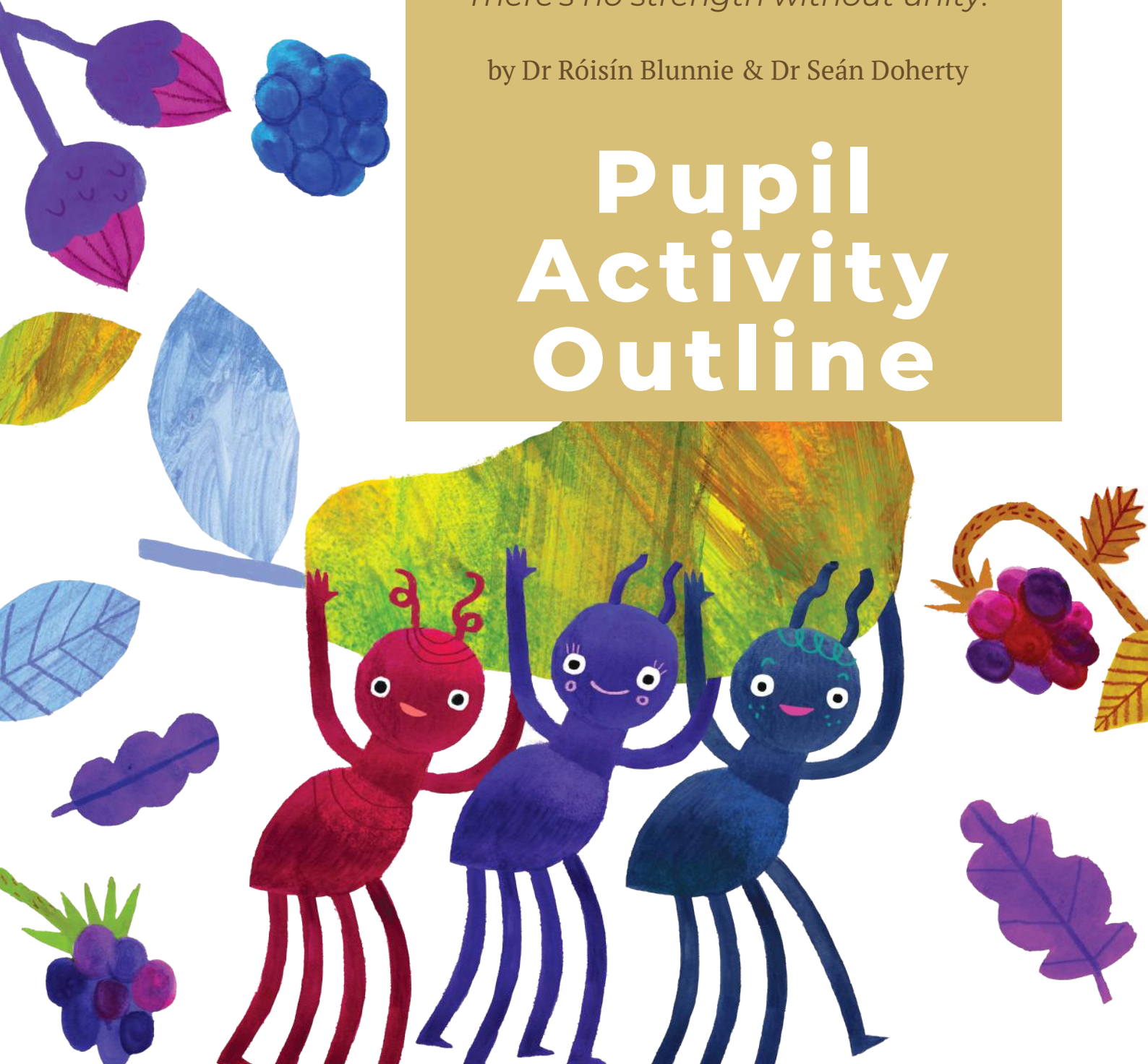


Ní Neart Go Cur Le Chéile

Ní neart go cur le chéile - a new song to learn and sing

Step 1

Watch VIDEO 1 to learn the words and know the meaning.

Then do the activity:

Draw some pictures or make a colourful poster to show some examples of when we can say 'ní neart go cur le chéile' – times when we work together or help each other to make something work out for the best.



Step 2

Listen



Watch VIDEO 2 to learn the song.
Sing along with the video.

Red writing = listen. Green writing = sing!

Then do the activities:

1. Make up actions or create a dance to go with the song. Invite family members to join in if you like!
2. Make a homemade instrument such as a rice shaker, and play along while you sing. To make a rice shaker, put some rice in an empty bottle, and shake!

Step 3

Watch video 2 again. Do you hear the jig coming in near the end (at 2.55)?

If you play an instrument, play the jig! You can learn the jig by watching video 3.

Then, play along with the song.
